Directions to UEA:

By car:

The postcode for Sat Nav is NR4 7TJ.

UEA has good road links and can be accessed:

- From the South via the M11 → A11 → A47 (Southern Bypass) → Earlham Road.
- From the Midlands/North from the A47 via King's Lynn or A14 to Newmarket then A11 to Norwich.

Parking on campus:

If you are driving to the conference, parking is available in the main university car park (campus map spot 5).

The car park has an Automatic Number Plate Recognition system in place. The entrance barrier will record your vehicle registration upon entry. When you leave, please visit the payment kiosk by the main bus stop to make payment before leaving the car park.

Blue badge parking

Blue badge parking is available in the main university car park. There are a limited number of accessible parking bays, so we recommend arriving early. You can park elsewhere in the main car park if these bays are full. More information is available [here](#).

Costessy Park and Ride

Day delegates can use the Costessey Park and Ride (route 511) which is free for UEA staff, students, and visitors. It is located on Long Lane, Norwich, NR9 3LX.

The service runs Monday to Friday, throughout the year and buses run up to every 30 minutes during the University's summer vacation. The journey takes approximately 15 minutes, or 20 minutes after 18:00hrs.

By train:

Norwich Train Station is the closest train station and is 4.5 miles away.

From the station you can:

- Take First Bus route 25 or 26 (Blue line) directly to campus. Buses run every 10 minutes and the journey takes approximately 30 minutes. When you reach UEA, get off at the main bus stop opposite the Main Car Park. For more information, please visit the [First Bus website](#).
- Take a taxi. The journey takes approximately 15 minutes.

By coach:

National Express run coach services from London (service 490) with a pickup/set down point located in the layby outside the UEA ZICER building (campus map spot 30).

Directions from UEA to The Assembly House:

By bus:

Take [First Bus route 25 or 26 \(Blue Line\)](#) from the **University Drive bus stop** (opposite the main campus car park) to **Red Lion Street** in the city centre. From the Red Lion Street bus stop, The Assembly House is a 5–10 minute walk, heading south towards Theatre Street.

By taxi:

A taxi takes approximately 10 – 15 minutes depending on traffic.
