#### **SLS Additional Support Fund**

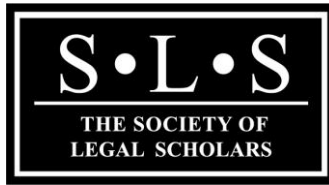
To support members of the SLS who do not have sufficient institutional funding to speak at the Annual Conference, the Society makes available an *Additional Support Fund*. #### **Presentation Slot**

There are 27 subject sections, with sessions offered in parallel. Each subject section will host sessions over 2 days with a maximum of 4 sessions; each session lasts for 1 hour and 30 minutes.

Sessions will have 3 presentations, and each speaker will have 20 minutes to speak. This limited time for all speakers allows for an opportunity to ask and respond to questions during the session. If you are speaking in a session that has 2 presentations, or a panel session of 4 speakers, your subject section convenor will confirm how long you will have to speak.

All delegates will be invited to ask questions, these could be asked immediately after each paper or at the end of the session as determined by the convenor.



**We do not require you to pre-record your presentation and would ask you to deliver your presentation, at the time scheduled, in real time on the day.**

To join your session, you will be sent a zoom link around a week before the event. **Please ensure you arrive 15 minutes prior to the session commencing.** You are invited to participate and listen to the other speakers within the same session, however, please note the chat function will not be enabled, and we are unable to offer virtual access to the other sessions within the subject section.

Please note your session will not be available for other delegates to join virtually or be recorded.
